Dear Mr. Morris:

Congratulations! On November 27, 2018, the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) Board of Education voted to renew Endeavor College Preparatory Charter with Benchmarks for 5 years, beginning July 1, 2019, until June 30, 2024, to serve up to 663 students in grades TK-8 in each year of the charter term.

We, the LAUSD Charter Schools Division, look forward to continuing to work with you throughout the term of the charter. As your assigned administrator from our office, I will continue to keep in close contact with you in order to perform our state-mandated oversight duties. If this assignment should change, we will notify you of the change and provide contact information for your new administrator.

Additionally, please keep in mind Endeavor College Preparatory Charter must meet the following operational benchmarks during the 2019-2024 charter term as described below:

The school must provide an annual update to the Charter Schools Division by December 1 of each year of the charter term demonstrating its progress related to the following:

ACADEMIC BENCHMARKS

1. The school shall demonstrate growth of at least one performance level per academic year on the English Language Arts indicator for measuring “Academic Performance” on the California School Dashboard, as reported by the California Department of Education (CDE), for all students and for all of the school’s subgroups, with the goal of achieving and maintaining the “Green” performance level or higher on this indicator by the end of the charter term.
2. The school shall demonstrate growth of at least one performance level per academic year on the Mathematics indicator for measuring “Academic Performance” on the California School Dashboard, as reported by the California Department of Education (CDE), for all students and for all of the school’s subgroups, with the goal of achieving and maintaining the “Green” performance level or higher on this indicator by the end of the charter term.


3. Annually, the school will increase the percentage of English Learners demonstrating English Language Proficiency as measured by *reclassification rates* at a rate equal to or higher than the District Average.

Please communicate with us by December 14 the name of the person who will be responsible for monitoring and following up on the benchmarks during the term of the charter.

Again, we congratulate your accomplishment and offer our best wishes as you continue to serve the students at your school and move forward the work of providing an excellent educational opportunity for all students.
