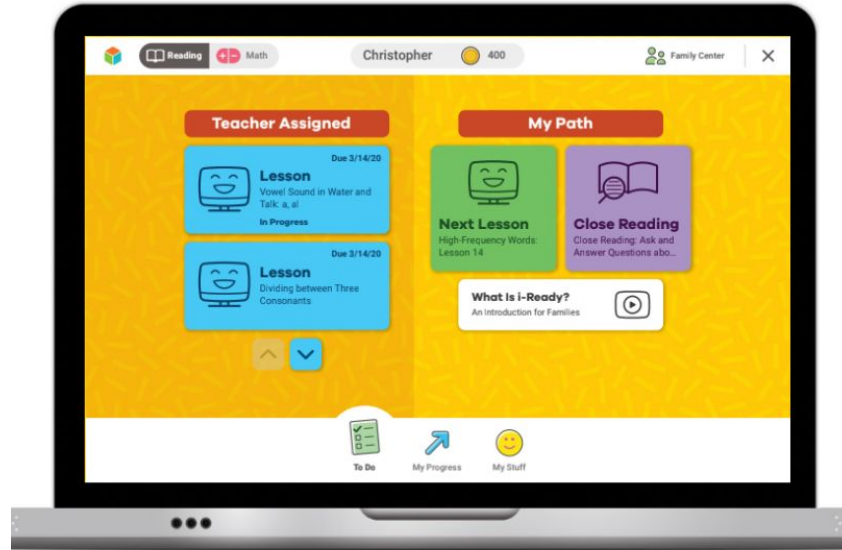

# I-Ready Testing Overview and Tips

## What is *i-Ready*?

*i-Ready* is an online program that will help us determine your child's strengths and areas for growth, personalize their learning, and monitor their progress throughout the school year. *i-Ready* allows us to meet your child where they are and provides us with data to inform instruction.

The *i-Ready Diagnostic* is an adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit your child's needs. **The purpose of this is not to give your child a score or grade but to determine how to best support their learning.**

# I-Ready Testing Overview and Tips

## What can I do to help?

To help prepare your child for the *i-Ready Diagnostic*, encourage them to:

- Get a good night's sleep and eat a full breakfast the day of the assessment.
- Try their best on each question and try not to rush.
- Try not to worry about questions they do not know—remind them that it is expected they will only get about half of the questions correct.
- Use paper and pencil to show work for math questions.



# Attendance Policy and Zoom Expectations

- Students are still required to attend online class each school day
- Students must join at least 30 minutes of ELA and 30 minutes of math when live instruction is provided

# Attendance Policy and Zoom Expectations

- Zoom (best practices)
  - Make sure cameras are on and directed at students
  - Log-in a few minutes early to be ready
  - Have scratch paper and a whiteboard nearby
